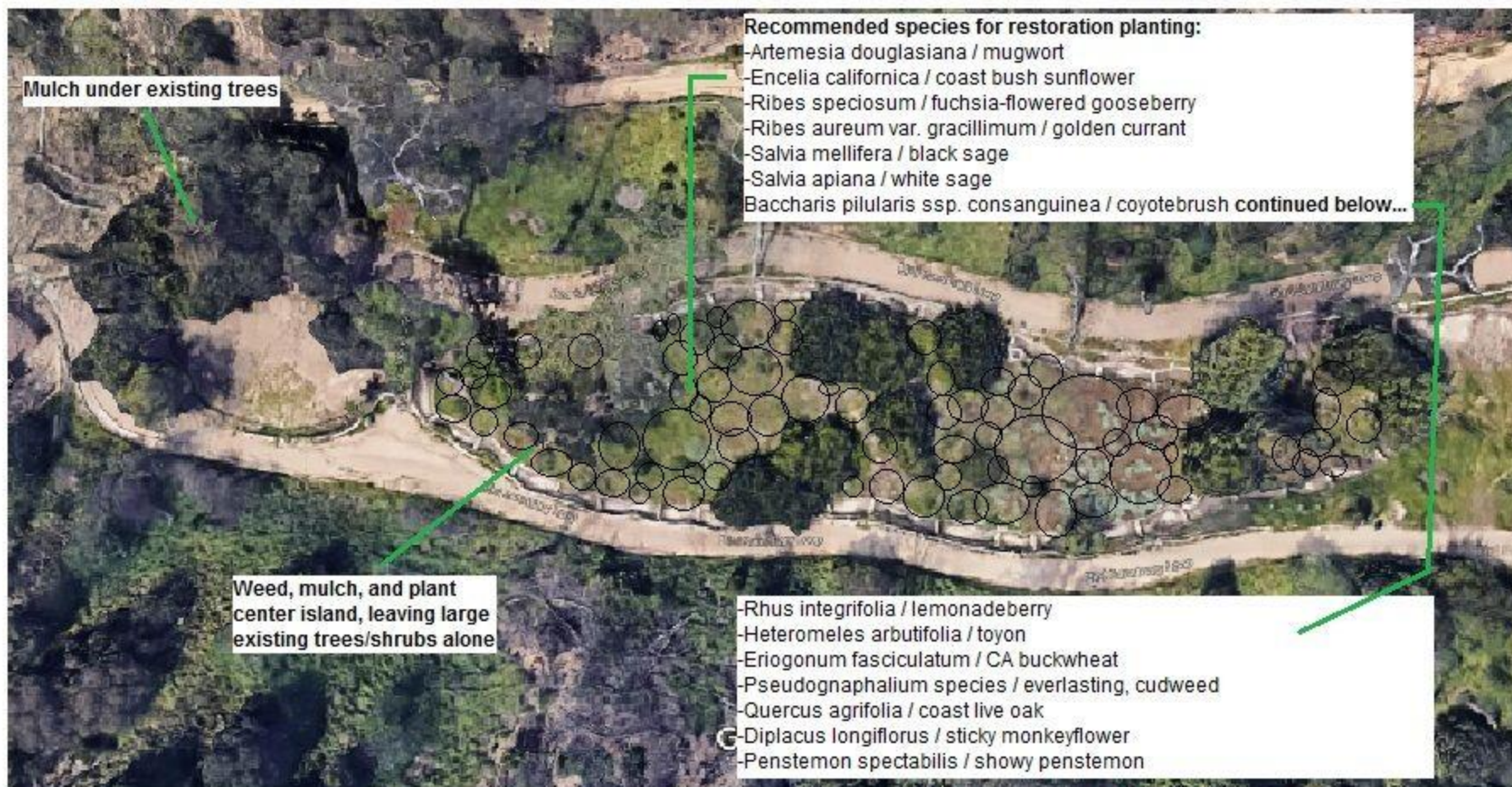

*3 – Spread mulch 3' diameter around plants*

*4 – Pull invasive Vinca minor (periwinkle)*
